



Function

The NOVACdC 12000 module is capable of managing a two-way heating circuit (Mod. 121000) or a three-way circuit (Mod. 12110). It allows for the metering of user consumption for both heating and domestic hot/cold water. The alternative to an individual heating system is a centralized system with individual heat metering and autonomous temperature control. This system combines the advantages of both centralized and individual heating systems, thanks to individual meters—each user pays only for the heat they have actually consumed.

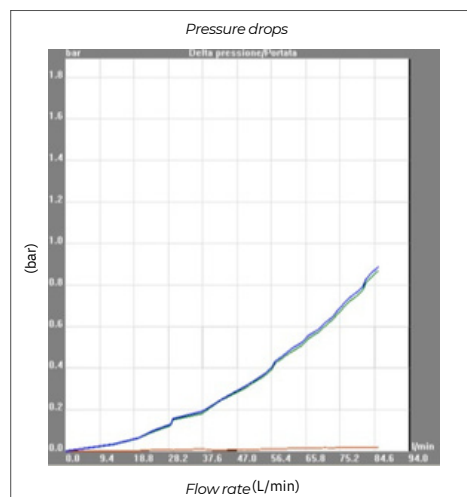

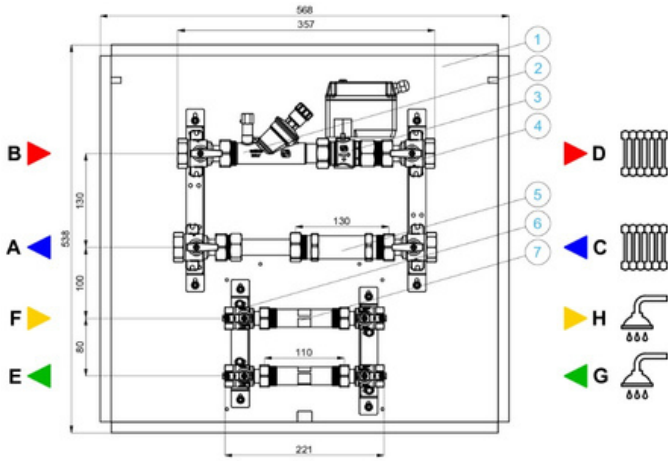

HEATING PRESSURE DROPS

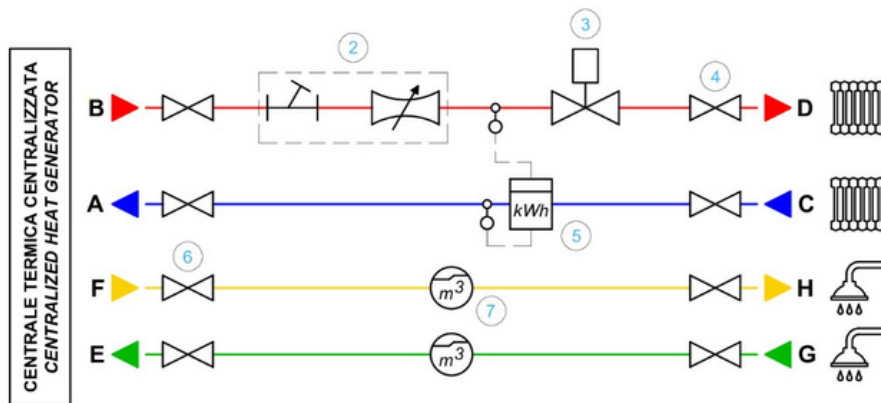
